## General Instructions

- 1) Attendance:-Pupils are expected to be present in the college on all working days in time. 80% attendance is necessary to appear the annual examination.
- 2) Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings. It is not advisable for the pupils to bring money or valuable articles, mobiles with them. The college will not be responsible for any loss.
- 3) Every pupil should endeavour to keep up high tradition of the college by excelling in good manners.
- 4) Parents can meet teachers only on Saturday with prior permission or appointment (except for any genuine reasons)
- 5) A pupil will have to pay a fine of Rs.50 for the replacement of an I-card.
- 6) The parents are advised to report any serious physical condition or a disability of the ward to the class teacher so as to give proper support to the ward in class.(heart conditions, epilepsy, hearing /visual impairment, allergies, psychological disorders etc)
- 7) The pupil's name could be struck off the register in case-
  - a) He/She proves to be a moral threat (bad influence) to other pupils and does not take steps to retract himself/herself even after two written warning memo.
  - b) He/She remains absent without information for more than a month.

- 8) Uniform: Students must come to the college in college uniform, along with proper haircut.
- 9) Students must wear Identity card everyday .
- 10) Students should not bring vehicles except bicycles. They should park the vehicles at the allotted 'students parking' place only which is located in the college campus.
- 11) Any act of misconduct and / or indiscipline will be considered by the authority and action against the same will be taken.
- 12) Strict discipline should be maintained in the campus.
- 13) Any damage and breakage of the college property done by the student in the class or about premises will be responsible for it. The decision of the Principal regarding the amount to be paid shall be final.
- 14) The students will not loiter around the premises after the college gets over. The college will not be responsible for their safety.
- 15) The students should be on time for the lecture or else will not be allowed to attend the class.

## **HIGHER SECONDARY SECTION (2018-19)**

### **Rules for promotion from Std. XI to Std.XII**

As per the HSC Board Circulars mentioned above, following are the guidelines for the process of promotion from Std. XI to XII.

- 1) A minimum marks for passing in every subject is 35% on an average of two unit tests and term I and term II examination in annual result.
- 2) If a student appears for all subjects and fails in one or more subjects, his/her deficiency of marks in maximum three subjects to a maximum of 15 marks but not exceeding 10 marks in any one subject shall be condoned for the purpose of passing the examination.
- 3) Although maximum 10 marks condonation is to be given in one subject such concession should not exceed the required minimum percentage of passing in the subject i.e.35%.
